

2008/2009 Trinity Swim Team Parent/Swimmer Agreement

We are fortunate here at Trinity High School to have a swim team for our students to participate in competitive swimming. Many private and public schools that are similar in size to ours cannot afford to run a varsity swim program and compete as a PIAA team.

While Trinity High School does provide funds for the swim team to cover the costs for coaches, officials, pool rental and expenses associated with PIAA Divisional competition, there are many expenses, such as expenses for states, bus fees for swim practices, invitational fees, banquets, senior gifts, shirts & caps, meals for away meets, clothing, etc. that must be paid for by the swimmers and their families. This equates to approximately \$7,000 in expenses that we need to raise funds for as a team each season.

In order to offset these expenses, we rely on donations and fundraisers, held by swimmers and parents order to cover these costs. It is expected that every member of the swim team and their families will support these events in order to participate on the swim team as follows:

- Each swimmer/family is expected to pay a ‘one time’ **\$25 meal fee** to off set costs for away meet meal expenses.
- Each swimmer/family is expected to volunteer to support the **pancake breakfast** fundraiser, as well as, sell tickets and/or pay the buyout fee.
- Each swimmer/family is expected to **volunteer** to help run home meets and support our swim team concessions at meets or basketball games.

We appreciate all swimmers’ and their families’ support in running another successful swim season. Together, our team can accomplish great things.
